Hope for the Hills, in conjunction with City, State and Federal leadership, has accomplished a **HISTORIC AND UNPRECEDENTED VICTORY** for our city, for our state, and for our nation! As a community we have:

- Beat a giant billion dollar utility. To the best of our knowledge, no utility has ever removed structures on a new project once they were constructed. We believe this is the first of its kind ever! A true "David versus Goliath" victory! And it was done in our community of Chino Hills!
- By getting the monster towers ultimately removed home owners will save equity and the city will not lose property tax dollars over the long term by maintaining real estate values.
- Prevented a strip of blight from being created through the heart of our beloved city. The entire community would have suffered from this.
- Saved citizens from suffering a variety of potential health issues related to massive radiation exposure over the long term if the towers were to have been strung and energized.
- It's going to be 6 months to 2 years before the monster towers are removed and the lines are buried along the 3.5 mile ROW. We will keep all citizens informed and aid the City in any way we can about the ongoing process.
- The estimated cost of taking the towers down and undergrounding the massive high voltage is approximately 8-9 cents a month!! This is a state wide project and the cost of it is being spread amongst all state electricity rate payers over several years!

We would NEVER have been able to accomplish this without the support and dedication of the residents of Chino Hills. We are a truly remarkable community and this amazing group of citizens accomplished the impossible. We stood together, fought a good fight and prevailed!! Thanks to EVERYONE who assisted this effort with their time, energy and perseverance!!

Over these many years our organization has learned much and we know that there are other communities out there battling similar situations, it is our desire to be a resource of information for organizing and battling against unsafe siting of High Voltage Transmission lines. Hopefully someday federal legislation can be created to set safe national standards for High Voltage Transmission right of ways, so that communities throughout the US can live without the fear of being exposed to high levels of EMFs.
