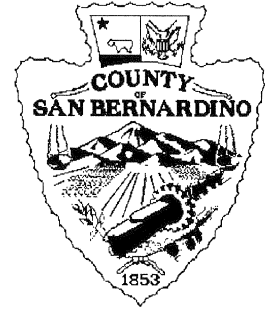

County Supervisor Gary C. Ovitt Urges the California Public Utilities Commission to Reverse Prior Decisions on TRTP

Fourth District County Supervisor Gary C. Ovitt has again urged the California Public Utilities Commission to reverse its decision allowing Southern California Edison to build a segment of the Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project through the middle of Chino Hills.

"I am proud to stand with the residents and the City of Chino Hills as they continue to fight these monstrosities in our neighborhoods," Supervisor Ovitt said. "The CPUC Commissioners can now see the damage that their decision has made. I urge the Commissioners to reverse this decision and have Southern California Edison remove these towers from our neighborhoods. 'Green energy' cannot come at this great a price."

Supervisor Ovitt is sending a letter to each CPUC Commissioner, as well as, to Governor Jerry Brown urging them to reverse their prior decision.

"It is great to see that CPUC President Michael Peevey has recently witnessed the damage that these towers have wrought on residents," Supervisor Ovitt said. "The State of California and Southern California Edison have not reached a point-of-no-return. This decision can and should be reversed immediately."
